Subj: FUNCTIONAL AREA CHECK LIST 330 05 011 FINANCIAL LIABILITY
INVESTIGATION OF PROPERTY LOSS

1. Cancellation. MCJROTC Policy Letter 5-16 of 10 May 2016.
2. The Financial Liability Investigation of Property Loss (FLIPL) investigative process replaces current Marine Corps policy of conducting investigations for missing, lost or stolen government property in accordance with the Manual of the Judge Advocate General (JAGMAN).
3. The change from JAGMAN investigation procedures to the FLIPL process will position the Marine Corps to be in alignment and compliance with Department of Defense (DOD) property control policies, procedures, and regulations with regards to the missing, lost or stolen government property. Alignment and compliance is critical to the Marine Corps in achieving and sustaining audit readiness and increasing property visibility and accountability.
4. The FLIPL, DD Form 200, is used to document the circumstances concerning missing, lost or stolen government property. It serves as, or supports, a voucher for adjusting the property from accountable records. It also documents relief from or a charge of financial liability against an individual.
